Convene conversations, promote best practices in product and packaging design for waste prevention


Construction & Demolition




Food Waste: a global problem





Food waste burdens our economy



Environmental impacts of food waste



LANDFILL

Underground, without exposure to oxygen, organics create methane gas.

Total cost of wasted resources: \$100 billion

Wastes associated with uneaten food include:

- Energy
- Water
- Labour
- Capital investment
- Infrastructure
- Machinery
- Transport, etc.
